

Protea Deep Secret

Robust new red hybrid. Red bracts with grey-green leaves. Slow growing bush.

Attractive in full flower. Prefers an open sunny situation in an acidic free draining soil.

Evergreen. Prune mid-late spring to encourage flowering in the following year..

Height: 1.5m x Width: 1.5m

Protea Valentine

A spectacular new Protea hybrid. Slow growing. Large red flowers sporadically through the year, and peak flowering in Spring. Green leaves.

Prune to shape after flowering has finished. Prefers full sun, open sunny position in a well drained acidic soil. Evergreen.

Height: 1.2m x Width: 1.5m

Protea Lepidocarpodendron

Green – Good Seconds!

An erect bushy shrub with medium sized greenish fls with a prominent black beard.

Intolerant to heavy frost.

Suited to varying soil types in coastal situations.

Prune to shape.

Protea Magnifica ‘Queen Protea’ (1.5litre pot)

Protea Floosie – Almost all year round flowering.

A semi spreading shrub which produces mid size Protea flowers. Flowering can occur almost all year round with peak flowering being from Autumn to Spring. The flowering bracts are **deep red and topped with a luxurious black tuft**. Plant in full sun in a well drained acidic soil. Prune back late Spring to size and shape. (3.3litre pot)

An attractive evergreen shrub with bluish-green foliage bearing bright pinkish-red flowers that emerge in Winter and through Spring. Thrives in full sun where soils are average and free-draining. Tolerates dry periods once established.

Telopea Brimstone Blush (Waratah) 1.5litre pot

H: 3m

An upright shrub robust shrub once established. Very free flowering

Sept/Oct with large reddish/pink flowers. Excellent cutflower.

Plant in full

sun or filtered light. Stake to support when planted. Prefers free draining

soils. Avoid fertilisers.

Protea Nerifolia Ruby (2.8litre pot -Good Seconds))

Also known as nerifolia Pink and the most well known Protea in home gardens from past years. Develops into a large shrub so cutting flowers and Spring pruning assist to limit dimensions in the early years. Adaptable to a variety of soils and climatic conditions. Deep pink flowers with black trim on top and a creamy central mass. Excellent cut flower.

H: 2.5m. F: Autumn-Winter. Medium frost hardy.

Protea Pink Ice (2.5-2.8litre pot – Good Seconds plants)

A vigorous tidy growing plant which is free flowering all year round. Flowers are a rich pink-red with a silvery appearance. It is adaptable to a wide range of soil types. Prune prior to Spring growth to shape & size.

Height: 1.5m

Protea Limelight (2.8litre pot) – Good Seconds.

A select low growing shrub noted for its lime greeny-white fls during Winter. Popular for picking. Suited to average well drained soils. Prune to shape.

Height 1.5 – 2m

Protea Obtusifolia Red – good seconds!

Red Flowers in Autumn to winter. Prefers full sun. Suitable coastal, and suitable summer dry.

Protea obtusifolia (Limestone Sugarbush) – Well shaped shrub to 9 feet tall with rich dark green leaves and large flowers with tightly overlapping pinkish red petals in fall though winter with some flowers lingering into spring. Plant in full sun in most any soil including clay and alkaline soils. Once established this plant is drought tolerant, requiring little irrigation. This long cultivated *Protea* is noted both for its beautiful flowers and for its reliability in the garden with long life and great tolerance for coastal conditions and alkaline soils (as high as pH 8.4). It is a great choice as a screening or hedge plant. To encourage dense growth and good branching structure plants should be pruned at a young age. The one drawback of this species is that it is not particularly cold hardy and early frosts can damage new growth, flowers and buds so protection may be required if temperatures drop below 29 F.

Protea grandicolor

Protea 'Grandicolor' is a large shrub with beautiful flowers and grey foliage,

this Protea plant can be used as a screening plant or as a feature plant,

it's flowers are very popular in floral arrangements. The grandicolor protea

is a beautiful peachy pink color. The tips of the petals are a fuzzy pink.

Flowers during winter and spring – good lasting flowers.

Easy to grow, proven frost hardy to -5°C, adaptable to most free-draining soils and tolerant to winds.
